We know when it comes to work issues and challenges, workers and learners “figure it out.” But how do we help boost their ability to discover solutions for themselves and make the process better, faster and cheaper? How do we craft learning strategies that extend the knowledge we provide them beyond the walls of training towards application to real work problems and situations?

Workflow Learning is a boots-on-the ground learning approach that is rooted in the knowledge that people are continuously learning in the workflow.

### Beyond the Walls of Instructions

Today there is a demand by top leaders to push training design and delivery beyond the walls of instruction-led learning towards learning in the workflow. Learning and training provide the foundational skills and knowledge. However, when workers go back to work after training, they face work issues not covered in the classroom, eLearning or even in support documents like FAQs and references. They also have forgotten many of the ideas. This problem leaves workers to fend for themselves and figure out how to deal with work issues. This often causes risks, liabilities, high operating costs, slow actions, and failures while workers are doing their work.

Although many trainers and designers add scenarios, games, simulation, and exercises to “approximate” the work issues, these methods, at best, are attempts to bring training closer to work applications. They are inadequate and cannot be relied upon to cover contingencies and exceptions that happen in daily work.

Therefore, it is imperative that trainers and designers enhance their requisite skills and knowledge along with helpful tools to design workflow.learning strategies.

### Two Distinct Workshops: Operations and Compliance

Oftentimes workers encounter challenges at work which may not have been covered during training. These issues are unexpected, unknown, and present deviations from standards, procedures, and results. These deviations cause delays, stoppages, low yields, breakdowns, equipment failures, high reject levels, low efficiencies, and many other undesirable outcomes. Workers need to get to the bottom of the work issues, figure out the answers, and apply that knowledge to handle the issues and challenges. Trainers and designers must find ways to utilize ideas from training, learning and performance support materials, with the purpose of enabling workers in their troubleshooting, problem-solving, resource allocation, prioritization, escalation, and collaboration with others to find and create immediate solutions.

In this workshop, you will experience first-hand how to design and deliver learning programs that help workers learn in the workflow. You will gain practical knowledge on how to extend Workflow Learning ideas to aid workers in resolving work issues related to inefficiencies, high costs, and low performance.
